

## **REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL**

**RE:** Request for a Primary Care Mobile Medical Consultant

### **Granted to UCSF Office of Developmental Primary Care on 12/16/15**

The Far Northern Regional Center (FNRC) is a private nonprofit organization under contract with the California Department of Developmental Services (DDS). FNRC is part of a statewide network of 21 Regional Centers responsible for the coordination and development of service to meet the needs of people with developmental disabilities in Shasta, Butte, Tehama, Siskiyou, Modoc, Trinity, Glenn, Lassen and Plumas Counties.

FNRC is seeking proposals for a Primary Care Mobile Medical Consultant to provide direct services for individuals residing in FNRC's service catchment area. The successful applicant will work with FNRC to develop clinical teams to provide direct services to individuals residing in specialized residential facilities. The teams will also provide education and support to other community healthcare agencies, including local primary care clinics, so that individuals may avoid placement in more restrictive settings.

Start up funding is available through FNRC's Community Placement Plan (CPP) funding. CPP provides services and resources to assist with moving individuals who reside at State Development Centers into the community, as well as assist individuals who are at risk of having to move into living settings outside of his or her home. Start up funding for the development is up to \$200,000.00.

Prospective applicants must have experience in providing services to individuals with developmental disabilities, including dual diagnosis of Developmental Delay and Mental Health Disorders, potential forensic involvement, substance abuse, behavioral needs, and cognitively challenged.

All interested parties are required to submit a proposal to FNRC. Proposals should include:

- a) A letter listing the applicant's name, address, phone number.
- b) Description of the applicant's education, experience related to the field of developmental disabilities.
- c) Service model proposal to meet the healthcare needs of Regional Center consumers.
- d) Budget proposal for the development of this program.
